Come with family and friends (3 - 6 people) to the Philippine Home Boat-builders Yacht Club's (PHBYC) Family Boat Building Weekend (4 - 5 April 2009) and experience a unique activity-packed weekend of learning, bonding, fun and sailing.

Registration fee per family/group for a **Sailing Summer Breeze kit** is ₱8,500. A **Summer Breeze hull only kit**, is ₱6,500\*, inclusive of:

- Boat kit (pre-cut panels, lumber, glue, fasteners & base paint)
- TLYC entry fee 3pax (₱100/extra person)
- Safety gear (dust masks, goggles & gloves)
- Quality instruction from experienced PHBYC volunteers
- Sailing version includes: sail, leeboard, rudder with tiller, bamboo spars, basic sailing instructions.

And at the end of it all, you will have your very own boat to use for fishing, exploring, rowing and even sailing!

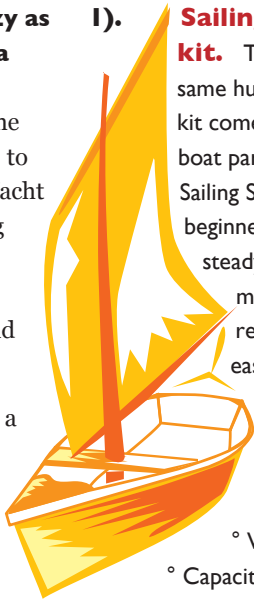
## To sail or not sail, that is the question...

Select the boat that best suits your needs.

### 1). **Sailing Summer Breeze kit.**

The sailing version using same hull as below! This 11' 8" skiff kit comes with all the necessary boat parts to get you sailing. The Sailing Summer Breeze is a fun beginner-friendly sailboat with rock steady performance in light to moderate winds. With removable mast and sail for easy vehicle-top transport or for conversion into a rowing or motoring boat.

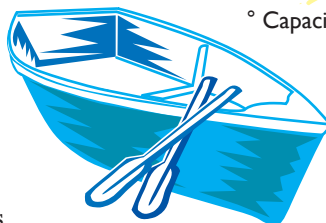
- Length: 11' 8"
- Beam: 4' 2"
- Weight: 125lbs
- Capacity: 500lbs.



### 2). **Summer Breeze (hull only).**

The 11' 8" foot skiff, an award winning design by David Beede, the Summer Breeze is a good all around dinghy that can be rowed, sailed or motored (with the addition of paddles, sail or outboard motor). PHBYC chose this design for ease of building, good load capacity and versatility.

- Length: 11' 8"
- Beam: 4' 2"
- Weight: 100lbs
- Capacity: 500lbs.



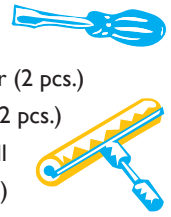
